

## **WSU CCHT Practicum/Internship/Volunteer Application**

The Center for Combating Human Trafficking (CCHT) at Wichita State University (WSU) accepts **Graduate Students** (or other persons with relevant practice experience) seeking practicum, internship, and/or volunteer placements. Dependent upon interest and skill, **Practicum/Internship/Volunteer Opportunities** may include the following:

Micro – individual and/or family survivor-centered case staffings through ASERCA and Faith-Based Multidisciplinary Teams; referrals and case facilitation for individuals who come to CCHT; etc.

Mezzo – planning/organizing/facilitating Multidisciplinary Team meetings for case change; facilitating psycho-educational prevention and intervention groups with young people (e.g. LOTUS™ Prevention for Prosperity Model with youth groups, school aged youth, etc.); facilitating reduce-demand groups with men; etc.

Macro – program planning, training, and implementation; community organizing; facilitation of collaborative practices; State and Federal policy review and legislative development; awareness education (e.g. creative projects with the Male-Focused ONE IS ONE TOO MANY CAMPAIGN); etc.

- Human Trafficking Awareness Month (January) event planning; conference planning, organization, and implementation;
- Creative projects to engage with, provide awareness to, and collaborate with students, potential partners, etc.

**Questions for 2-page writing sample** (choose at least three of the five questions):

1. What causes you to be interested in the anti-trafficking movement and/or anti-trafficking efforts?
2. Specifically, what interests you in the CCHT?
3. What have been your experiences working with those at-risk of and/or subjugated to human trafficking?
4. What do you believe are the largest contributors to trafficking?
5. If you had all the money and power in the world to do whatever it took to combat human trafficking, what would you do? What would be your prevention and/or intervention targets and strategies?
